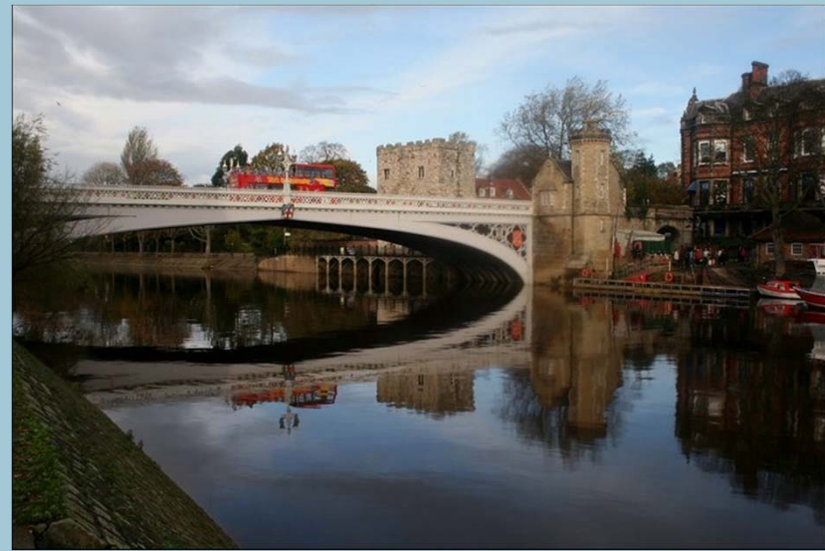
Organisation
